Keynote Speakers

Bishop Violet Fisher's call to ministry came at the age of 16. Though her roots were in the Methodist Episcopal Church, the affirmation for her ministry as an ordained clergy member came through The King's Apostle Holiness Church of God. In this church, she served as National Evangelist, and was the first woman to be ordained. During these years, she also taught in the public school systems of Virginia and Maryland.



Her journey brought her back to the church of her birth, and in 1988 she was ordained a deacon and in 1990 an elder in the Eastern Pennsylvania Conference of The UMC. Bishop Fisher served St. Daniel's UMC in Chester, PA, and Sayers Memorial UMC in Philadelphia.

From 1994 to July 2000, she served as district superintendent of the Mary McLeod Bethune District, and during her tenure on the district, was twice appointed dean of the cabinet. Consecrated Bishop in July 2000, she served two terms as the episcopal leader of the New York West Area. She now serves the church in the retired relationship. Bishop Fisher holds two Master's Degrees -- one in Education and the other in Divinity -- and a Doctorate in Divinity. She has a large extended family in the Maryland-Delaware area, including her son, Marcus, and her mother, sisters and brothers.

Dr. Alonzo Anderson A co-founder of One Light International and now serving as the Chief Operations Officer, Lonnie is a cognitive psy-



chologist with an extensive background in public policy and education with an emphasis on how children learn especially those from underserved communities or traumatized homes.

Dr. Anderson holds a Ph.D. from Michigan State University in Social Psychology with an emphasis in Small

Group Processes.

He has served as an Assistant Professor in the Department of Psychology at the University of California San Diego, Clinical Professor in the Department of Educational Psychology at the University of Southern California and as a Sr. Lecturer in the College of Education and Integrative Studies at California State Polytechnic University, Pomona.

In his "spare time," Lonnie serves as the Minister of Education at The Lord's Church in Los Angeles under Lead Pastor Velma Union.

What Is the Conference on Prayer & Healing?

The Conference on Prayer & Healing encourages adults and mature youth to explore the reality of prayer: logically, spiritually, and theologically. Worship

At the center of the Conference is its worship. Worship is spirit-filled with celebration and intimate praise of God. Ample time is given for praise, prayer, prophecy and the authentic movement of the Holy Spirit.

Workshops are offered so that Conference attendees can receive hands-on training in a variety of different areas.
